An LPFM radio station will allow Crusade for Christ Temple to better achieve its mission through community service, education, training students, and inspiration to its membership and others in the following ways.

Community Service

- Weekly programming covering health-related issues
- Regular programming on spiritual values and concerns
- Ministry and community service to shut-ins
- PSAs and community service bulletins

Education

- Weekly or biweekly programming led by church members and staff
- Fire safety and medical emergency information
- Weekly children's programming
- Educational broadcasts in the history and practice of the Christian tradition (including live and recorded worship services)
- Calendar and regular posting of concerns/outreach/other opportunities in the Richmond community

Broadcast Training

- We plan to include local high school and college students in the programming and broadcasting of the radio station

Inspiration

- As spiritual enrichment and as an encouragement and revitalization for the people of Richmond, we plan to provide music, religious services, and other related programs.
