

EXHIBIT 21 FCC 301 One-Step Upgrade for KVMX(FM)

2. Allocation Considerations

The instant application proposes to use the existing KVMX Class C1 transmitter site as both the Channel 298CO allotment and transmitter site. The attached spacing study shows that the proposed operation meets the co-channel and adjacent channel spacing requirements for Class CO stations as prescribed in §73.207 of the Commission's Rules.

An apparent short-spacing to KLRR 298C2 Redmond, Oregon, is moot, in that KLRR was authorized to change to Channel 269C2 by the Report and Order in MM Docket No.96-7, the same proceeding which authorized the upgrade of the KVMX Banks from Channel 298C2 to Channel 298C1. The KLRR modification to Channel 269C2 has been effected, and an application for modification of license (FCC File No. BMLH-19990419KF) is on file for the Channel 269C2 facility.
