

Re: TV Channel 6 Protection Agreement

Gentlemen:

KOIN TV, Inc. (KOIN), licensee of KOIN channel 6 TV in Portland, Oregon, presently leases antenna space to Mt. Hood Community College, (KMHD) licensee of KMHD FM, channel 206, in Gresham, Oregon. KMHD desires to share a multi-station master FM antenna installed on the KOIN TV tower. It is understood that KMHD has a tentative agreement with American Radio Systems (ARS) to share the use of this master antenna system. In accordance with 47 CFR Section 73.525, KOIN concurs with the proposed KMHD application to increase antenna height and ERP as follows.

1. KMHD will transmit using the ARS six bay FM antenna mounted on the KOIN TV tower. The antenna effective radiated power for KMHD will be 10.0 kW or less as permitted in Section 73.525(d)(1).
2. KMHD agrees to assume full technical and financial responsibility to satisfy all complaints of interference to reception of KOIN channel 6 TV resulting from KMHD FM transmissions for a period of one year commencing with KMHD program tests. Following the one year period KMHD shall provide technical information or assistance to complainants.
3. KMHD will cooperate fully with KOIN to facilitate all technical tests desired by KOIN including operation of KMHD at reduced power or terminating transmissions if needed.
4. Upon request from KOIN, KMHD will comply with all existing and future FCC requirements to protect technical personnel from exposure to radiofrequency radiation including operation at reduced power or terminating transmissions whenever necessary.
