TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Davidson County Broadcasting Co., Inc. (“Davidson County”), licensee of FM translator station W260BG, Channel 260D, Lexington, North Carolina. Davidson County holds a construction permit (BMPFT-20141229AGC) to make changes in W260BG. This instant application seeks a license to cover the outstanding permit. Exhibit A is a calculation of the transmitter power output for FM translator W260BG.

There are three special operating conditions/restrictions listed on the W260BG permit.

The first condition states:

“The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.”

Davidson County states that it will, in cooperation with other tower users, reduce the power of W260BG or cease operation, as necessary, to insure that persons having access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC’s guidelines.

The second condition states:

“Prior to commencing program test operations, FM Translator or FM Booster permittee must have on file at the Commission, FCC Form 350, Application for an FM Translator or FM Booster Station License, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 74.14.”

This application satisfies that condition.

The third condition states:

“THE PROPOSED FACILITY (FACILITY ID No. 148853) WILL NOT COMMENCE OPERATION ON CHANNEL 260D WITH FACILITIES AUTHORIZED HEREIN UNTIL WLXN (AM) (FACILITY ID No. 15838) COMMENCES OPERATION WITH THE FACILITIES AUTHORIZED IN BP-20140826ABE AND A LICENSE WILL NOT BE GRANTED FOR THE PROPOSED FACILITY ON CHANNEL 260D UNTIL A LICENSE IS GRANTED FOR WLXN WITH THE FACILITIES AUTHORIZED IN BP-20140826ABE.”

Davidson County verifies that WLXN has commenced operation under BP-20140826ABE under automatic program test and is in the process of filing FCC Form 302-AM for a station license.

Based on the foregoing, it is believed that Davidson County has complied with all conditions and can operate W260BG in accordance with Commission's rules.
