Dear Mr. Do:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 14, 2020. Intelli requests a further extension of the STA granted on December 3, 2018, to continue operating with reduced power to allow time to replace the old 50 kW transmitter (if unable to repair).<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, Intelli states that it has been unable to repair the transmitter over the past year.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is **HEREBY GRANTED**, and Intelli may continue to operate day and night with reduced power. Intelli must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310. Intelli must submit an



e-mail to my attention to note the date the station resumed licensed operations, or the date an FCC Form 301 application was filed to permanently reduce power (or make other desired changes).

This authority expires on **July 15, 2020**.
