

Dear Sir,

The station has made significant progress and was expected to return to normal operation by the time the most recent STA would expire. Since the last STA was authorized, the work to the fence has been completed, modifications to the lighting system have occurred and the tuning of all three towers has been accomplished. All construction work and tuning is complete. Testing has concluded the station can be restored to its normal operating power and pattern utilizing all three towers. As there were some physical changes to the north tower with a TV antenna being removed and some other accessories, the net effect has resulted in different monitoring point values. A simple resumption of operation would have the monitoring point values inconsistent with its current license. Thus a license modification application is necessary. It will take a little time for the application to be created and granted. The existing STA is expected to expire (8/16/2016) before the license modification could be granted. So this STA extension requests continued operation at variance to the license with the maximum power of 250 watts and different monitoring point values until the license modification can be submitted and granted. We expect to file the Form 302-AM within the next 30 days..
