

Contingent Applications Statement

New Wavo Communication Group, Inc., licensee of KVST, Willis, TX, proposes to upgrade KVST to Class C3 at Huntsville, TX, as part of a group of contingent applications pursuant to Section 73.3517(e) of the FCC's Rules. The instant application will be submitted concurrently with an application filed by American Family Association, Inc., licensee of KAFR, Conroe, TX, to change KAFR's community of license to Willis, TX, pursuant to the attached Facilities Modification Agreement.

Grants of the contingent applications will result in a preferential arrangement of allotments. Huntsville, TX will receive its first wide-area FM (Class C3) service. Willis will receive its first wide-area FM (Class C1) service and Conroe will retain numerous audio services.

KVST will substantially increase its service area. KVST will also serve 108,082 more people than its Class A CP facilities. While there will be a small reduction in population served compared to KVST's licensed facilities, the "loss" area receives numerous services. There will be no change to KAFR's service area. The FCC's "Rural Radio" rules will not be implicated, as KVST is moving further from the Houston Urbanized Area, and there will be and cannot be Urbanized Area coverage. Accordingly, grant of the contingent applications will serve Section 307(b) objectives.
