
Dear Applicant:

The staff has under consideration the above-captioned application for a modification to a construction permit.

An engineering study has revealed that the proposed transmitter site specified in the application fails to meet the minimum spacing requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 73.807. Specifically, the site proposed is located 76.6 kilometers from the licensed facility (BLED-20061018ABW) of WVPS(FM) on channel 300C in Burlington, VT. The required spacing pursuant to § 73.807 is 93 kilometers. The application fails to address this defect.

Accordingly, in light of the above, application BMPL-20141230ABD is unacceptable for filing and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
