

Multiple Ownership Showing

As stated in Exhibit 13, Bravo Mic Communications, LLC (“Bravo Mic”), the sole owner of the proposed assignee, is the licensee of Stations KVLC(FM), Hatch, New Mexico and KXPZ(FM), Las Cruces, New Mexico. Hatch and Las Cruces, New Mexico are located in Dona Ana County. The two Stations covered by the instant application – KMVR(FM), Mesilla Park, and KOBE(AM), Las Cruces, New Mexico, are also licensed to communities located in Dona Ana County. Thus, upon consummation of Bravo Mic’s proposed assignment, Bravo Mic will have an attributable interest in four stations located in Dona Ana County. Dona Ana County is not included in a defined Arbitron Metro area. As demonstrated herein, Bravo Mic Communications II, LLC’s ownership of Stations KMVR and KOBE will comply with the Commission’s multiple ownership rules.

Section 73.3555(a)(1)(iii) of the Commission’s Rules states that in a market with between 15 and 29 full-power stations, a station may own no more than six stations in total, and not more than four stations in the same service. Because Dona Ana County, New Mexico is not included in a defined Arbitron Metro area, the Commission’s rules require that a proposed assignee prepare a contour overlap study to demonstrate compliance with the local ownership rule.

The requisite contour overlap study was prepared by Cavel, Mertz & Davis, Inc. and is attached. The attached contour overlap study illustrates that there a total of 19 radio stations in the “market” and that there are fifteen radio stations not owned by the licensee or its parent whose principal community contours overlap the contours of the stations the assignee proposes to acquire. Because Bravo Mic will have an attributable interest in only four stations in the market, three of which are FM stations, the proposed

acquisition of Stations KMVR(FM) and KOBE(AM) complies with Section
73.3555(a)(1) of the rules.


