Dear Mr. Martinez:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 3, 2020. RVC requests a further extension of the STA granted on May 23, 2019, to operate with reduced power to allow time to complete repairs, including replacing the 50 kW transmitter (if unable to repair).<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, RVC stated that additional time would be needed to restore licensed operations:

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and RVC may continue to operate with reduced power, day and night. RVC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310. RVC must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the station resume licensed operations per BMML-20181105ACH

<sup>1</sup> KCKN(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1020 kHz with 50 kW (day and night), using a three tower pattern daytime, and a six tower pattern at night.

with negligible changes (or the date an FCC Form 302 application was filed to update all operating parameters).

This authority expires on **August 17, 2020**.
