Subject: W283BX, Galesburg, IL, waiver of CP expiration

Dear Mr. Howard:

On 3/29/2016, we received your request on behalf of Covenant Network (CN), for waiver of the construction deadline for a construction permit for FM Translator Station W283BX, Galesburg, IL, File No. BNPFT-20130328AUH, Facility ID No.156887, (Station) pursuant to 47 CFR §1.3 of the Commission's rules in accordance with footnote 36 of AM Revitalization First Report and Order, released on October 23, 2015 (1st R&O), and the Modification Window Procedures Public Notice released on October 26, 2015 (Notice). That footnote stated that a waiver of an Auction 83 FM translator construction deadline is presumptively in the public interest for applicants participating in one of the modification windows, provided that the AM station licensee proposing to use the FM translator for rebroadcasting its AM station commits to prompt FM translator station construction and initiation of broadcast operations. You state that CN plans to file an application for modification of CP (mod) in the Second AM Station Modification Window open from July 29, 2016 to October 31, 2016.

Although tolling is not specifically applicable to the circumstances of this case, we find that this request meets the criteria for waiver set forth in the 1st R&O and granted it on 3/31/2016.

Grant of the request is subject to the following conditions:

The waiver is effective as of 3/29/2016.

The waiver will remain in effect until grant of the mod CN plans to file in the second window. You must notify us within 30 days of the grant of the mod. Once the waiver period ends, the greater of the remaining term on the CP or 6 months will remain on the permit. Here, 6 months will remain.

This notification must be sent by letter to Secretary, FCC, 445 12th St., S.W., Washington, DC 20554, with a courtesy copy by e-mail to me at victoria.mccauley@fcc.gov.

When the waiver period ends we will calculate a new permit expiration date by adding the remaining 6 months.
