

Statement of Educational Objectives

Calvary Chapel of Elk Grove Village, IL., is a non-stock corporation that was organized under the laws of the State of Illinois and given tax-exempt status. It is also recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as a non-profit organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Calvary Chapel serves its community by providing adult teaching and training services several times each week. Calvary also provides training and teaching for youths and teens.

The radio station being applied for is to be used to further our educational programs described below, and to provide other local community groups an avenue to serve the community.

Calvary Chapel also plans to provide local news covering:

- Community events
- Local high school events including sports
- Weather warnings and school closings

The following is an expanded list of the education services offered by Calvary Chapel to its members and the community:

Adult Education

We hold neighborhood group meetings at a central location each week as well as in the homes of families and individuals. These meetings consist of Bible studies, classes on marriage and grief management and other topics that relate to adult issues like drug abuse and alcoholism.

We hold weekly prayer meetings for men and women as well as corporate times of prayer.

We also offer weekly men's and women's groups for the purpose of discipleship training in the Christian faith and fellowship which serves to encourage and support our members.

Our pastoral team routinely makes hospital visits for our members and for those of the community who have been referred to us.

For the last 8 years our church has been involved in a community mentoring program at a local elementary school where we provide love and support to the children as well as help them with reading and school work.

Our church also has a home-schooling ministry available to our members and the community to help with training and support for those who are thinking about or involved in home schooling their children.

Calvary Chapel provides pre-marriage, and marriage counseling classes to its members and the community free of charge.

Youth Education

Calvary Chapel is involved with the youth of our community by providing mentoring programs, and weekly youth classes for elementary, junior high, and high school students to help train them in character issues as well as encouraging them to pursue abstinence and a drug-free lifestyle.

Children's Education

Calvary Chapel provides children's church classes each week at the local community center.

We also host a Vacation Bible School each summer for the children of our church and community free of charge.

We have numerous events throughout the year for young children and their families like our Fall Harvest Fest and Summer Family Picnic.

The radio station will allow us to do even more for the community in the way of outreach, teaching and training in Christian education, marriage counseling and training, grief management, and the overall strengthening of families.

Furthermore, the station will enable us to reach out to and touch a much broader segment of our community including families and individuals unable to personally attend services and events and those with no affiliation with our organization.
