Dear Art:

This letter confirms my professional opinion that the transmitting facilities for the several FM stations at the South Mountain antenna farm in Phoenix, Arizona, were operating, at the time of our visit in the spring of 2003, in compliance with the FCC's guidelines limiting public exposure to RF energy. The site was entirely fenced, to preclude public access, and as summarized in our report dated September 30, 2003, measured power density levels in all publicly accessible areas near the site were found to be well below the most restrictive public limit. Subsequent calculations were made of power density contributions in areas of occupational access, particularly on the several towers at South Mountain, and we included in our report extensive power reduction schedules for access at any height on any tower. Based on information recently provided by Mr. Robert Reymont of Double R Consulting, a new Occupational Exposure Guide was developed in 2004 and all stations at the site have agreed to abide by its directives for restricting access to areas with the potential for power density levels to exceed the applicable occupational limits. On that basis, it is my professional opinion that the FM stations are also operating in compliance with the FCC's guidelines limiting occupational exposures.
