

**Transaction Description
and
Dismissal Request**

Pedro Roman Collazo, the licensee of WVOZ (AM), San Juan, Puerto Rico (Facility ID 54958), is also the President and 100% stockholder of International Broadcasting Corporation (“**IBC**”). IBC is the licensee of the following stations (collectively with WVOZ(AM), the “**Stations**”):

In early 2011, a Petition was filed with the General Court of Justice, Court of San Juan in the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, seeking a declaration that Pedro Roman Collazo be found disabled and requesting appointment of his nephew, Angel Roman Lopez, as the legal guardian for Pedro Roman Collazo. The Court was presented with evidence that Mr. Pedro Roman Collazo was suffering from dementia caused by Alzheimer’s and various other medical conditions. On October 3, 2011, that court entered a judgment granting the petition for declaration of disability and appointing Angel Roman Lopez as the Legal Guardian of Pedro Roman Collazo (copy attached).

On December 12, 2011, applications were filed on Forms 316 seeking consent to the involuntary transfer of control of the Stations, File Numbers BTC-20111212AHF and BTC-20111212AGU, to Mr. Lopez as Legal Guardian. These applications remain pending at this time.

Pedro Roman Collazo succumbed to his illnesses on February 2, 2012. A notice advising the FCC of the death of Mr. Roman Collazo was filed on February 9, 2012 (copy attached). Pedro Roman Collazo died intestate. In the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, executors may be named in a will, but where no will exists it is customary, in the absence of a dispute among presumed or purported heirs, for there to be no executor or trustee appointed by a court to oversee the estate or manage the decedent’s assets during the probate period. As Mr. Roman Collazo died intestate, there was no named executor, nor was a petition brought for an executor or trustee to be appointed while the the heirs were determined. During this time, Mr. Lopez simply continued managing Mr. Roman Collazo’s assets pursuant to his prior appointment as Legal Guardian. On August 10, 2012 the Court of First Instance, Superior Courtroom of San Juan, for the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, declared Angel Roman Lopez and Ruth Roman

Lopez as the sole heirs of Pedro Roman Collazo (copy attached). Thus, pursuant to court order, Angel Roman Lopez and Ruth Roman Lopez have inherited Mr. Roman Collazo's interests in the Stations' licenses.

We request dismissal of the applications seeking consent to the involuntary transfer of control to Mr. Lopez as Legal Guardian, File Numbers BTC-20111212AHF and BTC-20111212AGU, as moot, and further request grant of the instant applications for transfer of control to Angel Roman Lopez and Ruth Roman Lopez.
