Dear Mr. Wood:

This is in reference to the request filed on October 29, 2019. WLP requests a further extension of the STA granted on November 8, 2018, to continue ND operation to allow time to complete repairs due to damage caused by a 2017 hurricane and subsequent flooding.¹ In support of the request, WLP stated that additional time is needed to complete all required repairs.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:


- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and WLP may continue to operate using tower #2 with a maximum of 1.25 kW (day and night). WLP must reduce power or cease operations if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. WLP must file an FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters after repairs have been completed, or submit an e-mail to certify the date the station resumed operations per BL-19991104ABQ (with negligible changes).

¹ WYEL(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 600 kHz with 5 kW (day and night).
