Request for Extension of Silent Special Temporary Authorization

FM Translator Station W208AT, Coshocton, OH (Facility ID 92405)

Pursuant to Section 74.1263 of the FCC's Rules, The Ohio State University ("OSU"), licensee of FM translator Station W208AT, Coshocton, Ohio, respectfully requests an extension of Silent Special Temporary Authorization ("STA"), through May 20, 2012, to allow for a continuation of the translator station's existing off-air status. The FCC previously granted STA for W208AT's silent status on August 18, 2011 in FCC File No. BLSTA-20110525AAF, and the STA is currently due to expire on February 14, 2012.

As OSU previously notified the Commission, Station W208AT was forced off-air on May 20, 2011 due to circumstances beyond OSU's control, namely the translator's displacement by the commencement of operation of new, co-channel full service station WHVY-FM in Coshocton, Ohio. Following the grant of Silent STA for W208AT, OSU has taken substantial steps towards restoring service over its translator by pursuing displacement modifications to its license. In particular, OSU prepared and filed a minor change application for W208AT on December 20, 2011, proposing the use of Channel 202 for this translator. The minor change displacement application is currently pending in FCC File No. BPFT-20111220ABE.

Accordingly, OSU now seeks an extension of W208AT's Silent STA to allow sufficient time for continued processing of the modification application, and for OSU to complete build-out of the proposed facility changes and to commence operation following the issuance of a construction permit. An STA extension grant will therefore serve the public interest by allowing OSU the opportunity to pursue and complete its proposed modifications as needed to restore service over the translator facility.

OSU is a noncommercial educational broadcaster and operates W208AT on a noncommercial educational basis. Moreover, OSU qualifies as a governmental entity. The licensee is therefore exempt from filing fee requirements pursuant to Section 1.1116 of the Commission's rules and exempt from regulatory fee requirements pursuant to Section 1.1162 of the Commission's rules.
