


### Statement

I, Robert J. Murley, am president of Video Marketing Network, Inc. I have reviewed the Opposition to the Petition to Deny, and the facts stated therein are true and complete to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief. Further, I state as follows:

1. Television station WASV-TV was acquired by Video Marketing Network on June 13, 1989. At that time WASV-TV was an operating television station, and it remained in operation until December 15, 1989.
2. In December 1989, the station's general manager quit suddenly and left the station, and the station was closed temporarily. While the station was closed, thieves broke into the main studio, and stole substantially all of the studio equipment. In the process of ransacking the offices, files were strewn about, mixed together, and in the process, some files were lost. Such files as were available were boxed up and taken back to the corporate headquarters in Sarasota, Florida for sorting.
3. At that time we were not represented by counsel. I was unaware of the requirement to obtain permission to remain silent, or that we had to keep the public inspection file in Asheville, since the station was not on the air. There was no reason not to comply with the Rules and we would have complied if we had known the Rules. I had received my official notification from the Commission that the license did not expire until August 1, 1993.
4. I received a letter from the Federal Communications Commission in April of 1992, advising me that a license renewal application must be filed with the Commission. The company obtained the services of an experienced broadcast owner, Harvey M. Budd, who recommended the law firm of Cordon and Kelly. Mr. Kelly prepared the necessary documents and sent them to me for signature; I signed the documents and returned them to Mr. Kelly. It was not until the filing of the objections by Cannell that I learned that the ownership report for Video Marketing Network had not been filed with the 1992 license renewal application. We were in the process of completing the current ownership report for the license application, and I requested present counsel to prepare all of the necessary reports for the period of the Video Marketing Network ownership. During the entire time that the station was owned by Video Marketing Network, I personally had voted in excess of 80% of the outstanding stock of the Video Marketing Network, and from June of 1989 there have been only minor changes in the officers and directors. I have always been the president, a director, and the chief operating officer.
5. During the time that the Video Marketing Network was the

licensee of WASV-TV, the station never deliberately violated any rule, regulation, or policy of the Commission. Any violation that did occur was through inadvertence and lack of knowledge on our part.
