Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed September 8, 2011, on behalf of MLB-Dayton IV, LLC ("MD4"). MD4 requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on June 29, 2011, to operate a temporary FM Booster.¹ In support of the request, MD4 states that it has completed the initial testing, but that it needs to conduct "synchronization testing".²

Our review indicates that the proposed, brief test is not likely to result in interference to any other station, and that the Public Interest would be served by the proposed test operation to determine whether reception of Station WCLI-FM can be improved in the problem area.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WCLI-FM may continue to operate a temporary FM Booster with the following facilities:

Geographic coordinates:	39° 43' 26" N, 84° 12' 43" W (NAD 1927)
Channel	268 (101.5 MHz)
Effective radiated power:	0.05 kilowatt (Max-DA, H&V)
Antenna type:	3-element Yagi, directional
Antenna orientation:	135°
Antenna height:	

¹ WCLI-FM is licensed for operation on Channel 268A (101.5 MHz) with effective radiated power of 6 kilowatts (H&V) and antenna height above average terrain of 100 meters.

² We note that MD4 filed an STA request to test a second FM Booster on September 21, 2011; it is assumed that MD4 plans to test simultaneous operation of the two facilities. The second STA request is granted today by separate letter, for a term of 30 days. Thus, the instant extension request also is granted for 30 days.

above ground:	10 meters
above mean sea level:	240 meters
above average terrain:	-22 meters

MD4 must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **October 22, 2011**. No further extension of this authority is contemplated.
