

**MULTIPLE OWNERSHIP EXHIBIT
BILLINGS BROADCASTING, LLC
KWJK(FM) CHANNEL 226C3 – BOONVILLE, MISSOURI
DECEMBER 7, 2010**

This statement was prepared on behalf of Billings Broadcasting, LLC. (“Billings”). Billings is filing an FCC Form 301 minor modification application to increase the effective radiated power and deploy a directional antenna for KWJK(FM) Facility ID# 86486, licensed to Boonville, Missouri and as such a Radio Market analysis is required. Billings is also the licensee of KWRT(AM), Facility ID No. 5225, licensed to Boonville, Missouri and FM Translator K278BG, Facility ID# 31892, licensed to Columbia, Missouri. Neither KWJK(FM) or any of the other subject stations are licensed to a metro county in any Arbitron rated market. Therefore, a contour overlap study for stations not licensed to metro counties is necessary. Neither Billings Broadcasting, LLC, nor any of its shareholders own or have any other media interests.

Because all of the subject stations are licensed to non-metro counties, a contour overlap analysis has been conducted for ownership compliance. A study has been conducted which verifies that the minor change application for KWJK(FM) is in compliance with the Commission’s multiple ownership rules, based on the revised contour overlap rules. The combined city grade contours of KWRT(AM) and KWJK(FM) were used to determine the number of other stations in the “Defined Radio Market”. These combined city grade contours were considered the “Radio Market Boundary. No stations with transmitters more than 92 km from the boundary of the common overlap of subject stations will be considered. The number of stations in the Defined Radio Market falls in the 15 to 29 stations level. Therefore, common ownership or control of up to six stations with no more than four in the same band is permissible. Billings Enterprises, Inc. owns or has interest in only two full power stations, one in each band. Because overlapping contours from only two other full powered radio stations were required to show compliance with Section §73.3555(a), (ownership of no more than 50% of the stations in the defined market), a detailed map was not provided. Billings will produce such a map if the Commission so requests. Based

on the review of the non-rated market, the minor change application for KWJK(FM) is in compliance with the Commission's revised contour overlap rules. It is believed that the KWJK(FM) minor change application for Channel 226C3 at Boonville, Missouri is in compliance with §73.3555(a) of the rules.
