

Description of Transaction

By this application, the parties seek the Commission's consent to the assignment of the licenses of television broadcast stations KMYT-TV, Tulsa, Oklahoma (Facility ID No. 54420), and KOKI-TV, Tulsa, Oklahoma (Facility ID No. 11910), from Newport Television License LLC ("Newport") to KTVU, LLC ("Cox").

On July 19, 2012, Newport Television LLC, Newport, and Cox Media Group, LLC ("CMG") entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement (the "Agreement"). Pursuant to the Agreement, CMG agreed that it or its permitted assignees would purchase the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") licenses and other assets of the following television broadcast stations:

KOKI-TV, Tulsa, Oklahoma;
KMYT-TV, Tulsa, Oklahoma;
WTEV-TV, Jacksonville, Florida; and
WAWS(TV) Jacksonville, Florida.

CMG has assigned its rights under the Agreement for the purchase of KOKI-TV and KMYT-TV to CMG's affiliate KTVU, LLC.¹ This application is one of three applications for assignment of license on Form 314 filed for consent to the transactions described in the Agreement.

Pending Renewal Applications: Television stations KOKI-TV and KMYT-TV each are required to file an application for renewal of license on or before February 1, 2013. Accordingly, this statement is submitted in furtherance of the Commission's policy permitting processing of long-form applications for multiple stations that involve a subset of stations with pending renewal applications where (1) no basic qualifications issues against the seller and buyer were raised or, if raised, were resolved favorably, and (2) the buyer explicitly assents to standing in the stead of the seller in any renewal proceeding that is pending at the time of consummation of the change of control. The parties hereby request that the Commission apply that policy in the event that the transactions described in this application have not been consummated by the date of the filing of the KOKI-TV and KMYT-TV renewal applications.²

In accordance with the Commission's requirements for applying its policy, KTVU, LLC hereby agrees to succeed to the position of Newport in any renewal applications pending for the stations subject to this application as of the consummation of the transaction described herein, consistent with the procedures set forth in *Shareholders of CBS Corporation*, 16 FCC Rcd

¹ CMG has assigned its rights under the Agreement for the purchase of WAWS(TV) to CMG's affiliate Cox Radio, Inc. and its rights for the purchase of the WTEV-TV licenses and certain other assets of WTEV-TV to Bayshore Broadcasting LLC ("Bayshore"). Bayshore is not affiliated with CMG, and CMG has no attributable interest in Bayshore.

² A similar request is included in the concurrently filed long-form FCC Form 314 application for assignment of the Commission licenses for television station WAWS(TV), Jacksonville, Florida, which is due to file a license renewal applications on or before October 1, 2012.
