


DECLARATION

ECCS is the licensee of numerous noncommercial educational FM Stations and FM Translators in Colorado and Wyoming (see attached). I am fully aware of all of the community grade contours of Educational Communication and hereby attest that none of them overlaps with the instant application contour.

**RESOLUTION AMENDING THE BYLAWS
OF
EDUCATIONAL COMMUNICATIONS OF
COLORADO SPRINGS, CO.**

WHEREAS, EDUCATIONAL COMMUNICATIONS OF COLORADO SPRINGS, INC. (ECCS”), will apply to the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) for authorization to operate FM radio stations at Creede, Silverton, Compo, Springfield, Seibert, Burlington, South Fork, Julesburg, Westcliffe, Wray and Swink, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, there are likely to be competing applicants for the frequencies sought by ECCS, and in such cases the FCC selects the applicant who achieves the highest score under certain criteria, one of which is “diversity of ownership,” which favors applicants who certify that they and their officers and directors do not, and may not under the applicant’s organizational rules, have an attributable (ownership or official) interest in other radio stations whose principal community (or city grade) contours overlap the principal community contour of the station applied for.

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to enable such certifications through an amendment to ECCS’s By-Laws because it neither operates nor intends to apply for other stations with principal community contours which would overlap the applicable ECCS application contours, and because none of its officers or directors is known to have an attributable interest in any such stations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors that the By-Laws of ECCS are hereby amended to add the following paragraph:


“In the event that ECCS files applications with the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) for construction permits for noncommercial educational FM stations at Creede, Silverton, Campo, Springfield, Seibert, Burlington, South Fork, Julesburg, Westcliffe, Wray and Swink, Colorado (the “ECCS Applications”) and seeks to be awarded points by the FCC for diversity of ownership, ECCS shall not during the period the ECCS Applications are pending and for at least four years of station operation (i) seek consent from the FCC to obtain another AM, FM or FM translator station whose principal community contour would overlap with that of ECCS’s Application or stations; (ii) elect or permit to serve as an officer or director of ECCS any person who has an attributable interest in any AM, FM or FM translator station whose principal community contour would overlap with that of ECCS Applications or stations; or (iii) take any other action which would jeopardize ECCS’s entitlement to an FCC credit for diversity of ownership in connection with the ECCS Applications. The provisions of this paragraph shall expire and have no force or effect as to any ECCS Application if and at such time as the FCC dismisses or denies that application and that action becomes final.

The definitions of the terms “principal community contour,” “attributable,” and “final” shall be those contained in the rules, regulations, and policies of the FCC.”

CERTIFICATION

I am Chairman of Educational Communications of Colorado Springs, Inc. ("ECCS"). I certify that ECCS will commit to maintain the Board characteristics on which its Creede, Silverton, Campo, Springfield, Seibert, Burlington, South Fork, Julesburg, Westcliffe, Wray and Swink, Colorado applications base their local diversity claims.

The following procedures will be used to notify prospective officers and/or board members, both currently and in the future, of their need to act consistently with ECCS's local broadcast diversity and localism representations to the Federal Communications Commission:

1. When a vacancy occurs, the appointing officers and/or board members shall be notified, in writing, regarding the above;
2. As part of the selection process, candidates will be asked to disclose their attributable media interests (as defined under Part 73 of FCC rules), and those candidates will not be added as members of the Board of Directors or as officers if their appointment would cause a conflict with local diversity credits claimed by ECCS.
