**TECHNICAL STATEMENT**

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Sea-Comm, Inc. ("Sea-Comm"), licensee of station WBNE, Channel 229A, Wrightsville Beach, North Carolina. In MB Docket #05-16, WBNE was ordered from Channel 229A at Wrightsville Beach, North Carolina to Channel 229C3 at Topsail Beach, North Carolina. Sea-Comm herein submits an application to implement the change in community of license and upgrade. Sea-Comm also proposes to relocate WBNE to a new site.

Sea-Comm is proposing to construct a new tower on which it plans to install the WBNE antenna system. As such, the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") has been apprised of this proposal. Once the FAA has issued its Determination of No Hazard, the proposed new tower will be registered with the FCC. From the proposed site, Channel 229C3 does not meet the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements to two other FM stations. Therefore, processing pursuant to §73.215 is requested (see Exhibit A for details).

All of the remaining exhibits used to certify the information on Form 301 have been forwarded to Sea-Comm and are available for submission to the Commission on request.
