

DUOPOLY SHOWING

Punjabi American Media, LLC has reached agreements to acquire the licenses of KOBO(AM), 1450 kHz, Yuba City, California (FIN 17408) and KIID(AM), 1470 kHz, Sacramento, California (FIN 65482). A computer study has found that there is a very slight overlap of their respective predicted 5 mV/m daytime contours; roughly 0.2 kilometer (see attached).

Yuba City is the seat of Sutter County, California, which is outside all Nielsen radio metro markets. Sacramento is the seat of Sacramento County, California and the largest city in the Nielsen-defined Sacramento radio metro market. Using the reference coordinates reported in the National Atlas of the United States, we have determined Yuba City is approximately 41 airline miles north of Sacramento.

The computer study shows that the transmitter sites of AM Broadcast Stations KUBA, 1600 kHz, Yuba City, California (FIN 56365) and KMYC(AM), 1410 kHz, Marysville, California (FIN 40633), are within the 5 mV/m contour of KOBO.

The FCC database shows that, in addition to KIID, the following AM stations are licensed to Sacramento:

Therefore, this application complies with Section 73.3555(a) of the FCC's Rules, as Punjabi American Media, LLC would only have attributable interest in two broadcast stations in the Yuba City-Sacramento area.
