To Whom It May Concern;

The construction permit for a FM translator BMPFT-20071001BYF W295AZ – 152950 Jacksonville Beach, Florida granted on October 02, 2007 has an AM proximity condition attached to it which we believe is unnecessary.

The proposed construction of translator W295AZ, consist of a side-mounted antenna on an existing grounded tower. The AM station involved, WJXL 1010 KHz. (BP20040112AAJ) is 36.5 km 276 degrees from W295AZ proposed site. The construction of the translator is trivial by comparison to the existing mass and height of the tower. An inspection of the tower, conversation with the tower management and WJXL show that it is grounded and not detuned for any frequency. Please see attached document and photographs.
