REDUCED POWER STA EXTENSION REQUEST

Multimedia Holdings Corporation, licensee of KUSA-DT, Denver, Colorado (“KUSA”) was assigned interim DTV Channel 16 and will return to its analog Channel 9 for post-transition DTV operations. The station is operating reduced power DTV facilities on Channel 16 pursuant to STA granted October 8, 2002, as extended, from a site in downtown Denver. The current STA extension will expire on March 24, 2008. A further six-month extension is respectfully requested to permit continued operation as previously authorized.

KUSA holds a construction permit to operate on Ch. 16 on Lookout Mountain where construction of a new community antenna and transmitter building are in progress. Upon completion of facilities on Lookout Mountain, KUSA plans to move its reduced power Channel 16 DTV operation to the mountain and to operate there at reduced power until the end of the DTV transition. It does not plan to complete construction of the full power Channel 16 facilities on Lookout Mountain. Therefore, pursuant to the Commission's recent order in the 3rd Periodic Review of the DTV Transition, and to carry over interference protection to its planned post-transition operations on Channel 9, KUSA has filed an application to modify its CP for Channel 16 specifying the reduced power facilities it proposes to operate until the end of the transition on Lookout Mountain. If necessary, it will seek a new Special Temporary Authority to operate those facilities pending grant of the modified Channel 16 CP.
