Interference Complaints

Dear Mr. Low:

This letter refers to the pending "Interference Complaint Under Section 74.1203" (Complaint) filed on March 19, 2018, by Rocket Radio Corporation, permittee of Translator Station K275CL,¹ Phoenix, Arizona (Rocket Radio) and the July 19, 2018, "Reply Interference Complaint Under Section 74.1203" (Supplemental Complaint)² alleging interference from FM Translator K275CP, Phoenix, Arizona licensed to Mountain Community Translators, LLC (Mountain).³

On August 20, 2019,⁴ the Media Bureau (Bureau) informed Rocket Radio that the Complaints did not comply with the Commission's rules (Rules) concerning translator interference.⁵ To continue



processing the Complaints, the Bureau directed Rocket Radio to file, within 30 days, certain additional information detailed in the *Bureau Letter*. The Bureau further informed Rocket Radio that “failure to submit the required information will result in the dismissal of the Complaints.”⁶

To date, Rocket Radio has failed to respond to the *Bureau Letter*.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the “Interference Complaint Under Section 74.1203” filed on March 19, 2018, by Rocket Radio Corporation, permittee of Translator Station K275CL, Phoenix, Arizona and the July 19, 2018, “Reply Interference Complaint Under Section 74.1203” Rocket Radio Corporation ARE DISMISSED.
