

Engineering Certification Statement
In reference to permit file number: BPED-20000918AGG.

As the chief engineer for KNHC radio, I certify that the installation/repair of the KNHC antenna system was performed in accordance with good engineering standards. As has been previously reported to the Commission, it was discovered after the initial installation that the original antenna mounts had not been constructed per the antenna manufacturer's requirements, causing significant degradation of the station's signal performance.

The new antenna mounts have been checked against the antenna manufacturer's requirements and found to be correct. The new mounts and the antenna have been installed per the manufacturer's specifications. The antenna system is now operating properly and in accordance with the construction permit.

My qualifications are as follows, I am a current holder of FCC general radiotelephone operator license # PG - 13 - 15406, as well as being certified as a professional broadcast engineer by the Society of Broadcast Engineers # 50742, which expires on Jan. 1, 2006.
