We build community by providing a welcoming and communal workspace, knowledgeable volunteer staff, and the tools and parts for cyclists of all ages and skill levels to repair, maintain and acquire bicycles. TBR operates a self-service bicycle repair facility and holds regular education programs for youth and adults in our immediate community and beyond.

RADIO MISSION

If granted an LPFM radio frequency, we will create a bicycle-themed low-power radio presence throughout the city of Troy. We have the infrastructure in place to attract volunteers and will partner with local experts to provide training. Several in our organization have special expertise in electronic media and education, and we will apply these skills using radio to strengthen our mission. We will use radio to connect, educate and collaborate with our expanded network of community organizations committed to alternative transportation, health and welfare, and environmental sustainability.
