To Whom It May Concern:

On October 28, 2022, the KEZJ-AM transmitter experienced a catastrophic failure which took it off the air. The station immediately began operation on its licensed antenna with its auxiliary transmitter at approximately 100W.

The equipment failure was extensive, requiring multiple components and parts to restore the unit to operation. The factory has indicated that, due in large part to supply chain issues causing parts shortages and long lead times, as well as staffing and workload issues at their plant, several weeks will likely be needed to complete the repair.

We are requesting an Engineering Special Temporary Authorization in order to operate at reduced power during this time.
