


Supplement

My April 5, 2017 letter to Kevin Bae, which was submitted as part of the Pocatello Channel 15, LLC failing station waiver is hereby supplemented by the following information:

Commencing in June 2016, I had conversations with representatives of a number of broadcast groups to ascertain if there was any interest in acquiring KPIF. Specifically, I spoke with representatives of Ion, Univision, Grey, Sinclair, and Nexstar. None of these entities were interested. Thus, I concluded that the only realistic buyer would have to be an in-market player.

I am the Secretary of Pocatello Channel 15 L.L.C. ("Pocatello"). Pocatello is the licensee of KPIF(TV), Pocatello, Idaho, Facility ID No. 86205. I also function as the operations manager for the station. In that capacity I have periodically had interactions with various national advertising sales reps in an effort to obtain national advertising accounts on KPIF. These efforts were not fruitful because I was advised that KPIF has an audience share of less than two percent (2%).
