

Results of a quick reception survey after the conversion of KPTN to digital on Channel 36.

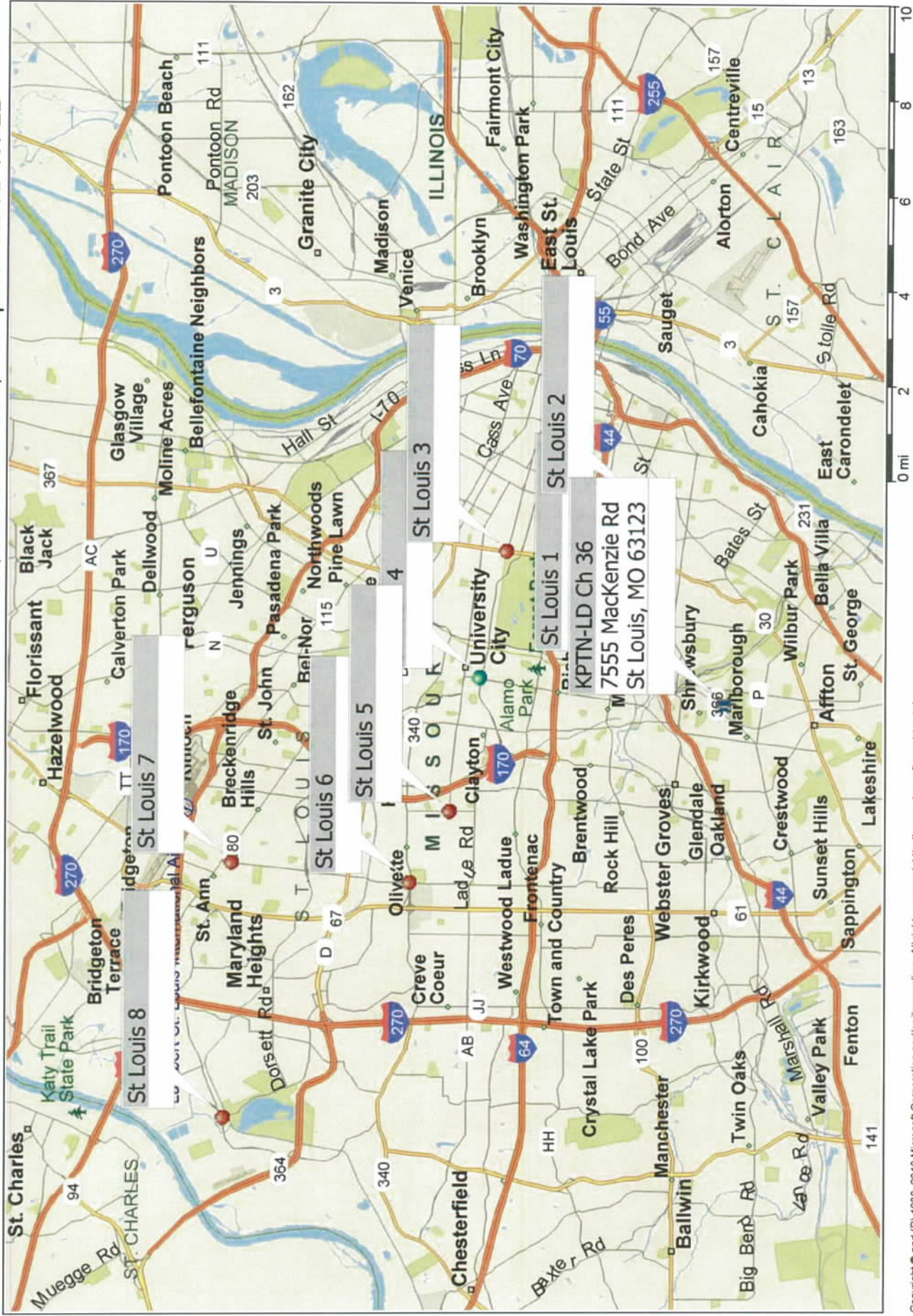
I did a quick (6 hours drive around) survey after the TX was up. This was a brief make sure it is working type of survey due to the time frame.

- 2) Arsenal St below Tower Grove Park – Good
- 3) Lindell and N King Highway BLVD – NG
- 4) N. Big Bend Blvd & University Dr – Good
- 5) Delmar and N. Price Rd – NG
- 6) Olive Blvd and N. Warson – NG
- 7) Ashby Rd & San Carlos Lane – NG
- 8) Marine Ave & near Maryland Heights Expy (but South of it) – NG

Locations were picked that were not behind obvious obstructions. Weather was cold and overcast. Temp was brisk. It had been raining but wasn't at the time. Signal was good so I suspect interference but did not have an analyzer with me to confirm.
