Gentlemen: Kiowa County has requested analog STAs to cover their lapsed licenses -

DK48DW, DK50AA, DK52AA, DK54AB and DK56AG.

They failed to renew their licenses during the last renewal phase due to the death of the person who handled their translator matters and the resulting loss of historical knowledge and management of FCC matters.

They request a waiver of the December 31, 2011 shut off date for the out of core channels. They will be filing digital STA requests for DK48DW, DK50AA and 3 new in-core channels later this week. They have appropriated funds in their 2012 budget year for the conversion to digital and will be placing orders for the digital equipment later this week. They expect delivery of new digital equipment in February or March and will cease their analog operation at that time.

The County feels it is in the public interest in this rural part of the state to continue their analog service until they can complete the purchase and installation of equipment for digital operation.
