Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed December 3, 2009, on behalf of Costa-Eagle Radio Ventures Limited Partnership ("CERV"). CERV requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on March 24, 2009, and modified on May 26, 2009, to operate FM Translator W221CH with reduced power.¹ In support of the request, CERV states that extension of STA is necessary while the Commission resolves an interference complaint against the translator.

Our review indicates that the public interest would be served by grant of the requested STA.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station W221CH may continue to operate with reduced effective radiated power of 60 watts (Max-DA). CERV must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **June 15, 2010**.

¹ W221CH is licensed (BLFT-20090127ABA) to Newton, New Hampshire for operation on Channel 221D (92.1 MHz) with effective radiated power of 0.15 kilowatt (H only). Construction Permit BPFT-20090130AAI authorizes relocation of the translator to Lawrence, Massachusetts, relocation of the transmitter, and operation with ERP of 0.25 kilowatt (Max-DA, H&V). Application BLFT-20090226AAA, for license to cover the permit, is pending before the Commission. Thus, the permit facilities will be considered as the "licensed" operation for STA purposes.
