

BASIS FOR TRANSFER

This application seeks the transfer of negative control of Kommerstad Communications Company, LLC from Robert M. Kommerstad, deceased, to his wife, Lila M. Kommerstad.

Robert M. Kommerstad died on July 11, 2002. Mr. Kommerstad had been a co-managing member of Kommerstad Communications Company, LLC. His wife, Lila M. Kommerstad, was the other co-managing member of Kommerstad Communications Company, LLC. As such, they each held a 50% voting interest. They also each held a 1% equity interest. The remaining 98% of the equity was held by the Kommerstad Family Trust of which Robert M. Kommerstad and Lila M. Kommerstad were the sole trustees.

Lila M. Kommerstad, as trustee of the Kommerstad Family Trust, is the sole residual devisee of Robert M. Kommerstad's estate. Under the California Probate Code, Section 13101, Ms. Kommerstad has elected to transfer Robert M. Kommerstad's 1% interest in Kommerstad Communications Company, LLC to the Kommerstad Family Trust. Attached is the declaration Ms. Kommerstad has filed with the California Probate Court. Under California law, this interest is transferable outside of the estate. No probate proceeding is required with respect to this interest or to the administration of Mr. Kommerstad's estate.

As a result of this transfer, Lila M. Kommerstad will acquire 100% voting control of Kommerstad Communications Company, LLC, holding 1% of its equity individually and 99% as the trustee of the Kommerstad Family Trust. Pursuant to the informal advice of the Commission's staff, since the transfer is of a 50% interest to an individual that presently holds 50% of the voting rights in the licensee, this transfer can be accomplished on an FCC Form 316.
