**Explanation of Circumstances Warranting Grant of STA**

Pappas Telecasting of the Gulf Coast, L.P. (“Pappas”) holds a license from the Commission that authorizes Pappas to operate UHF commercial low-power broadcasting station KVVV-LP in Houston, Texas on NTSC Channel 53. Station KVVV-LP bears the Commission’s Facility Identification Number 6690.

Pappas holds an outstanding construction permit from the Commission in File No. BPTTL-20040519ADW, granted on June 1, 2004 (the “Permit”), to relocate the facilities of Station KVVV-LP to a new, permanent location. Pappas has concluded negotiations for the lease for the new location. On March 10, 2006, Pappas took Station KVVV-LP off the air, as described in letters submitted to the Commission on behalf of Pappas on March 13, 2006, and March 21, 2006, in order to commence the process of moving the station’s transmitting facilities to the permanent location authorized in the Permit. However, this process has not yet been completed.

Pappas respectfully requests a special temporary authorization (“STA”) for Station KVVV-LP to remain silent for six months, through and including October 7, 2006, in order to complete the relocation of its facilities to the location authorized in the Permit. The public interest will be served by a grant of this STA because this will enable Station KVVV-LP to complete the relocation authorized in the Permit, and after such relocation is complete, to resume normal operations.
