

SHOWING OF COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 73.3555

Buckley Broadcasting Corporation of California ("Buckley") is the licensee of KNZR(AM), Bakersfield, California and KLLY(FM), Oildale, California. Upon consummation of the KRME(FM) assignment application (see FCC File No. BALH-20001003ACA; granted 11/22/00), Buckley will become the licensee of KRME(FM), Shafter, California, which is the subject of the instant application. In addition, Buckley Broadcasting, Inc., which is commonly owned with Buckley, is the licensee of KKBB(FM), Bakersfield, California. The principal community contours of KNZR(AM), KLLY(FM), and KKBB(FM) form an area of mutual overlap with the facilities proposed for KRME(FM) in the instant application.

A party, even in the smallest radio market, may own, operate, or control up to five commercial radio stations, not more than three of which are in the same service (AM or FM), so long as the party does not own, operate, or control more than 50 percent of the stations in that market. See 47 C.F.R. § 73.3555(a)(1)(iv).

Buckley will own four (three FM and one AM) commercial radio stations in the relevant market. As shown in the attached engineering statement, this market includes over 25 commercial radio stations. Thus, upon implementation of the proposed changes to KRME(FM)'s transmission facilities, Buckley's ownership in the market will be in full compliance with the Commission's radio duopoly rule.
