Dear James,

This is to certify the completion, to proper engineering specifications, the installation of the all equipment to effect the construction permit, grant # BPED-19990923 AAU, for WAYR-FM in Brunswick, Georgia. The transmitting equipment (Harris Z5 5kw) replaced the existing Harris 1kw. The work was performed by Bill Tidwell. The installation of the directional antenna was performed by Terry Creasy of Georgia Tower Services. The location, center of radiation and azimuth, was verified by Harris Surveying and Engineering Co., Inc.

My qualifications include practical and paper qualifications. I've been the chief engineer since 1987 for WAFT – FM and have responsible for all purchase, installation, and maintenance of the facility. I've recently (April 2002) become responsible for WAYR AM and FM. In 1987, I was responsible for the installation of the AM studios and helped in the installation of the transmitter and associated two-tower directional array. I worked full-time as a Motorola road and bench technician from 1982-87.

My paper qualifications include a diploma in electronics technology with RF emphasis from Valdosta Technical Institute (1980), a General Radio-Telephone FCC license with ship radar endorsement, # PG-6-25307. I became a member of the SBE in April 1996, member # M16177. I hold two transmitter certifications from Harris; one for the SX series (10/23/87), and for the FM-K/G/H series (2/5/88).
