**TECHNICAL STATEMENT**

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits are prepared on behalf of Miller Communications, Inc. ("Miller"), licensee of WWKT (FM) Channel 257C3, Kingstree, South Carolina. Miller herein proposes make changes to the facilities of WWKT by relocating the station, increasing the antenna height above average terrain and reducing the effective radiated power while maintaining a maximum Class C3 equivalent facility.

Since the Miller proposes to install the proposed WWKT antenna on a new tower structure, the Federal Aviation Administration has been apprised of this proposal. When the Determination of No Hazard is received from the FAA, the tower will be registered with the Commission.

From the proposed WWKT site, Channel 257C3 meets the minimum distance separation requirements to all other FM broadcast facilities under §73.207 of the Commission's rules. However, at the site proposed in this application, WWKT does not provide the requisite city grade signal over Kingstree, South Carolina, using the Commission's standard method of predicting city grade coverage. We have, however, determined that, using an alternate method of

depicting city grade coverage, the proposed WWKT facility will provide the required city grade coverage to Kingstree. Attached, as Exhibit A, is a demonstration this proposal complies with §73.315(a) of the Commission's rules. All other necessary documentation used to certify the technical portion of FCC Form 301 has been forwarded to the applicant and is available for submission to the Commission upon request.
