Dear Mr. Martinez:

This is in reference to the request filed on July 23, 2019. RVC requests an extension of the STA granted on May 23, 2019, to operate with reduced power to allow time to complete all required repairs, including replacing the 50 kW transmitter (if unable to repair).¹ In support of the request, we noted that RVC stated that additional time was needed.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and RVC may continue to operate with a reduced power of 1 kW, day and night. RVC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310. RVC must submit an e-mail to my attention to certify the date the station was able to resume licensed

operations per BMML-20181105ACH with negligible changes. Otherwise an FCC Form 301 application must be submitted if RVS desires to permanently reduce power or propose other changes that require a construction permit.

This authority expires on **February 4, 2020**.
