Audio Division Staff:

SM-KRTR-AM, LLC (“Licensee”), licensee of KPRP(AM), 650 kHz, Birmingham, AL (Facility ID No. 13880) (the “Station”), by its undersigned attorney, hereby requests an extension of its existing Engineering Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to operate the Station at 1 kW daytime power, which the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) granted by File No. BSTA-20220225AAH.

After this Engineering STA was granted, the Station timely resumed operations (Resumption Notice File No. 20220301AAE) under the STA’s parameters. Licensee continues its diligent efforts to obtain necessary parts and coordinate the installation process needed to replace its transmitter and resume licensed operations. Out of an abundance of caution, Licensee respectfully requests a six-month extension of its STA to complete the necessary work. Licensee will notify the Federal Communications Commission expeditiously once it has an update regarding its operational status.

Licensee hereby certifies that neither it nor any party to this application is subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862. Licensee also hereby certifies that the statements here are true, complete, and correct to the best of its knowledge and belief, and are made in good faith.
