This is written on behalf of KVMD Licensee Co., L.L.C. ("KVMD"), the licensee of Stations KVMD, Digital Channel 23, Twentynine Palms, California, and KIMG-LP, Analog Channel 23, Ventura, California.

You have advised KVMD that KJLA, LLC's ("KJLA"), the licensee of Low Power Television Station KSMV-LD, Channel 23, Los Angeles, California, proposes to file an application with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") seeking to modify its antenna pattern.

In connection with the application that KJLA is submitting, KVMD was made aware by you that the operation of the modified antenna pattern of KSMV-LD, from its transmitter site on Mt. Wilson, is predicted to cause interference to the proposed operations of KVMD and KIMG-LP in excess of the threshold permitted by the rules and regulations of the FCC. KVMD has reviewed this matter with its engineering consultant and is aware of the locations where it will occur and the level of interference that KVMD and KIMG-LP are expected to receive.

After due consideration, KVMD wishes to confirm that it has no objection to the request KJLA is submitting to the FCC for modification of KSMV-LD to modify its antenna pattern.

KJLA is authorized to submit this letter to the FCC in support of the Form 346 application that it plans to submit.



Dear Mr. Wilkinson:

This is written on behalf of KVMD Licensee Co., L.L.C. ("KVMD"), the licensee of Stations KVMD, Digital Channel 23, Twentynine Palms, California, and KIMG-LP, Analog Channel 23, Ventura, California.

You have informed KVMD of an application that your company is preparing to file with the FCC requesting the modification of license of KSMV-LD, Los Angeles, California.

To insure interference free operation to our Stations, KVMD and KIMG-LP, we have agreed to your proposal to have KSMV-LD make use a "full service mask filter" in place of the stringent mask filter permitted by FCC rules. Based on the engineering information we have reviewed, this agreement to allow the use of a full-service mask provides for the benefit of interference-free operations for all of our stations.

Pursuant to FCC requirements, you must first secure from us, as the licensee of the affected adjacent television stations, our written consent to our employing a full-mask filter.



Therefore, we are providing this written consent to you that will permit you to inform the FCC that no adjacent television station objects to our proposed use of a full service mask filter.
