Reply to SRC's letter of response dated April 10th, 2015

Once again, SRC by their counsel claims Starstation Radio, LLC. fails to provide the “required public interest” in our application to relocate. To the contrary, when community leaders, along with the mayor and town council specifically request the Commission grant a license to serve their community which is not otherwise being served, that strongly demonstrates the highest level of public interest.

Starstation's application is materially accurate, meets all technical requirements and was prepared by a leading engineering firm. A firm often used by SRC for their own engineering needs. Starstation is convinced beyond any doubt that SRC would have no interest in our application and would not have filed an objection if it were not to protect their signal from any unwelcome interference from our distant adjacent channel signal.

It would be interesting to study the history of objections filed by SRC. Does SRC always review applications to relocate, making sure every I is dotted and every T is crossed? Or, does SRC only file an objection when an application could possibly hamper their present signals or future development. Contrary to SRC's claim, there is no attempt to divert the Commission's attention, but only to question again whether this objection by SRC is made in good faith, and why SRC would have any interest in whether or not there is an allotment to serve Buckhead, GA. As stated in our previous letter, Starstation firmly believes this is a tactic designed to eliminate any possible threat to SRC's 100.5 FM metro Atlanta signal from our distant station on 100.7 FM.

We respectfully beg the Commission to apply the true spirit of the rules in granting our application without further delay, as the town of Buckhead, GA has requested of you.
