The FCC has granted a construction permit for a new analog television facility on channel 35 licensed to Vicksburg, Mississippi (BPCT-19961001LB) ("WUFX"). The WUFX permittee's application to the FCC for that construction permit indicates that the new analog operations by WUFX on channel 35 are predicted to cause unique interference to the WCBI-DT signal on channel 35 for approximately 3000 viewers in the WCBI-DT service area. According to the permittee's application, these 3000 viewers represent 0.41% of the population within the WCBI-DT service area, which is within the permitted allowance of new interference under the FCC's rules. As of the date of this Agreement, to the knowledge of Seller, WUFX has not yet

commenced operations. Seller can make no assurance as to the actual interference that may be received by the WCBI-DT digital signal from the WUFX analog operations.
