Ground system consists of 120 equally spaced, buried, copper radials 91.4 m in length plus 120 interspersed radials 13.7 m in length.

Neither the license nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. This license is subject to the right of use or control by the Government of the United States conferred by Section 606 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.
