

DECLARATION OF ALEX COLLANTES

1. My name is Alex Collantes and I am the Vice President of Azteca Broadcasting Company ("Azteca"), licensee of KSVN-CA, Ogden, Utah with respect to the Joint Request for Approval of Settlement Agreement ("Settlement Agreement") attached to this declaration.
2. Azteca is the applicant for a minor modification to increase its power for KSVN-CA.
3. I certify, under penalty of perjury, that Azteca's application was not filed for the purpose of reaching or carrying out such a settlement agreement.
4. Additionally, I certify that Azteca or its principals have not paid, received, or promised any money or other consideration for reaching this Settlement Agreement with Caribou County TV Association.
5. Grant of this Settlement Agreement is in the public interest because it eliminates the need for an auction and will allow for the grant of both applications. Furthermore, Utah's growing Hispanic population will be benefited greatly by a power increase for KSVN-CA, allowing increased reach of its Spanish-language local programming service.
