

NON-PROFIT, EDUCATIONAL PURPOSE OF ASSIGNEE

The captioned applications are amended to clarify the non-profit, educational purpose of the proposed assignee herein, Christian Voice of Central Ohio, Inc. ("Assignee"). Assignee is classified by the Internal Revenue Service as a Section 501(c)(3) non-profit charitable organization. Assignee is organized under the laws of Ohio as a non-profit, non-stock, charitable corporation. As a non-profit corporation, Assignee has no beneficial owners, and is controlled by its governing board.

Under Assignee's articles of incorporation, Assignee is "organized and operated exclusively not for profit and for religious, literary and educational purposes . . ." Assignee is engaged in the dissemination of programming to educate the public concerning the benefits of living according to a moral code consistent with the virtues expounded in the Bible, and of the ability of the Christian religion to aid listeners with respect to their own individual issues, whether those issues relate to family problems, mental illness, child abuse, alcoholism, drug abuse or other problems which are all too prevalent in modern society.

Using broadcast radio to disseminate its ideas enables Assignee to address issues of religious and moral importance on a broad scale. Assignee, which already operates other FM radio stations in Ohio, has always provided the highest quality of programming, stressing spiritual and moral values. Assignee's programming always has been, and upon consummation, will be on the acquired stations, responsive to the problems, needs and interests of the community. All programming will be in good taste and suitable for listeners of all ages, while fulfilling Assignee's educational objectives.
