Dear Ms. Ward:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 19, 2014. EBL requests a second extension of the STA granted on June 21, 2013, to operate station WEEI(AM) with parameters at variance from license values and/or reduced power while completing a proof.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, EBL stated that most of the antenna system repair work has been completed and an FCC Form 302 application with a MOM proof should be filed within 30 days.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WEEI(AM) may operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power,



however it will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. EBL must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.<sup>2</sup> EBL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **June 25, 2014**.
