The City of Lompoc proposes to use this LPFM radio station to expand its ability to educate and communicate with the local community.

Used in conjunction with our existing City-owned PEG television studio, the station will be a valuable tool for use by City government. Proposed government programming includes City Council meetings, budget workshops and candidate forums. Police and fire agencies will make excellent use of this resource as well, both providing safety education oriented programming. It will also provide a valuable tool for notifying citizens of any potential emergency situations. With the studio proposed to be located at City Hall, emergency personnel would have 24/7 access for any community notification purposes.

The City also plans to work closely with the local high schools and college, providing opportunity for student participation and education.

Plans also call for live broadcasting of selected high school sporting events, providing the opportunity for those local residents who are unable to attend to enjoy the games as well.

In addition, the studio plans to encourage local non-profit organizations to participate by informing our citizens of the services they provide to the community. Also, by utilizing public service announcements and special programming to educate and inform the community of local events, public awareness and participation should increase. Safety issues, emergency procedures and safe practices will also be emphasized.
