As mentioned in our phone conversation, when I prepared the post-transition interference analysis on May 26th, the post-transition software showed no interference issues. Attached is a pdf of the OET-69 interference run. The WVUE-DR rulemaking (BPRM-20090528AFA) was filed after the KFOL-CA STA and minor mod. application and therefore the post-transition software did not include the WVUE-DR rulemaking facility. It is noted that WVUE is authorized for operation on channel 8 post-transition, and therefore we don't believe its licensed pre-transition channel 29 facility should be included in the current post-transition software.
