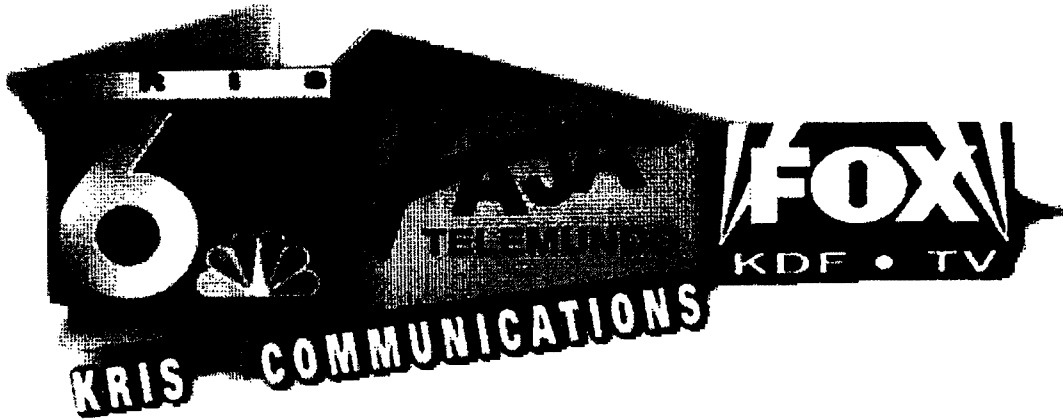

Re: Permission to file Power Increase for KFGG (KWRC), Channel 204, Corpus Christi, TX.


Dear Mr. Jenkins,
